


## Update Instructions



**BACKUP, BACKUP, BACKUP!!!** – While Golf Budde provides the ability for users to easily backup their database files, users are not forced to do so. However, if a hard disk crashes, a new computer is purchased, or a new hard disk is installed or reformatted, Golf Budde will probably need to be reinstalled. If no BACKUP was created, **all data will be lost!!!** If a BACKUP file of the Golf Budde database has been made, the user only needs to download the latest version of Golf Budde from the Budde Systems web site and copy the backed up database file to the C:\GolfBudde\DBFiles folder. This backup file is simply a copy of your current Golf Budde database file and can be kept on a floppy disk, CD or other storage media. By clicking on the Setup button of the main screen in Golf Budde, the current Golf Budde database name can be seen. This is the file that needs to be backed up.






**How to upgrade from version 1.x, 2.x, 3.x or 4.x** – When upgrading from a version of Golf Budde less than version 5, separate files are used to store Golfer, Course and individual player information. In some cases, the files have a GDB extension and some have DBF extensions. In either case, these files must be available for conversion to the newest version of Golf Budde. Upon successful conversion, the contents of these older files will be placed in one MDB file for the new program. If there are problems in converting these older files to the newest Golf Budde version through the Conversion Routine, email the entire directory (PREFERABLY IN A ZIPPED FORMAT) to Budde Systems and we will attempt the conversion process.



Upgrading is a simple process that starts on the Welcome screen. Click the Convert button to display the Golf Budde Conversion Utility. Follow the steps on this screen to convert the older database files.



**How to update Golf Budde from version 5.x** – When upgrading Golf Budde from version 5.1 to 5.3, simply download the SetupGB54Update.exe file from the following web site. This download is substantially smaller than the full download version.

Run the SetupGB54Update.exe and supply the directory location where the current Golf Budde program is running (i.e. C:\GolfBudde5\Golf52.exe)

Note that this installation program will install all of the files required to run GB54. GB5.x versions will remain available in case of an installation problem.

Since the Golf Budde application name changes to golf54.exe, a new shortcut icon will appear on your desktop.


After the installation is complete, double click the new GB54 icon on the desktop.

Before the **Welcome** screen appears, the following message box should appear:



By clicking OK, the **Welcome** screen should appear.

It is recommended that you click the “**Setup**” button on the **Main** screen, followed by the “**Resynch All Scores**” button. This will ensure that the GB54 changes will occur.




If the Update fails to work successfully, use a Windows Explorer and go to the C:\GolfBudde5\DBFiles folder (or wherever your Golf Budde database files are located). Delete or rename the current Golf Budde database file (i.e. GolfBudde.mdb) and rename the file GBPre54-yyyyMMMddHHmmss.MDB back to the current Golf Budde database filename. Then run your old GB5.x program.

**Upgrade Costs** – When upgrading Golf Budde from a version number lower than the current version the upgrade cost applies. The following table simplifies the upgrade cost question:

Golf Budde Version	Upgrade Cost
1.x, 2.x, 3.x, 4.x	\$10 US
5.x	No charge

**Have a database issue? Having trouble upgrading? Send Budde Systems your database via email.** – Simply click on the Setup Screen’s, System File Check button.



This will expose the System File Check results screen. Any Date, Size or Version with a yellow background signifies that an out-of-synch file is being used. Click on the Email button to send a copy of the System File check along with the current Golf Budde database file (already zipped for user convenience) to Budde Systems.
